Paul led his first SOMA team (to Burundi) in 1990, and he has subsequently led teams to Nigeria and Kenya, as well as visiting Rwanda on two occasions on behalf of the Bishop of Winchester. Paul's passion is to communicate the unchanging Gospel of Christ in a language that today's people can understand and respond to. In this he's been enormously helped by his experience in cross-cultural mission work with SOMA and others.

Sheila Moore



Nine years ago Sheila left behind a 25-year advertising career to pursue God's call into a life of prayer. Today this has evolved into a ministry centred in intercession. As well as leading intercession and prayer initiatives in her local church, Sheila is a member of the steering group of Pray Ealing and is prayer co-ordinator of Churches Together in Hanwell. She is also a Trustee and prayer minister at Shalom Christian Healing Centre in Northolt, Middlesex. Sheila co-ordinates intercession for a number of local initiatives, from night shelter projects for the homeless, to an ecumenical mission initiative to coincide with the 2012 Olympics. She also co-ordinates parish-based intercession when members of her church are on overseas missions and has herself been on a team to Tanzania.
